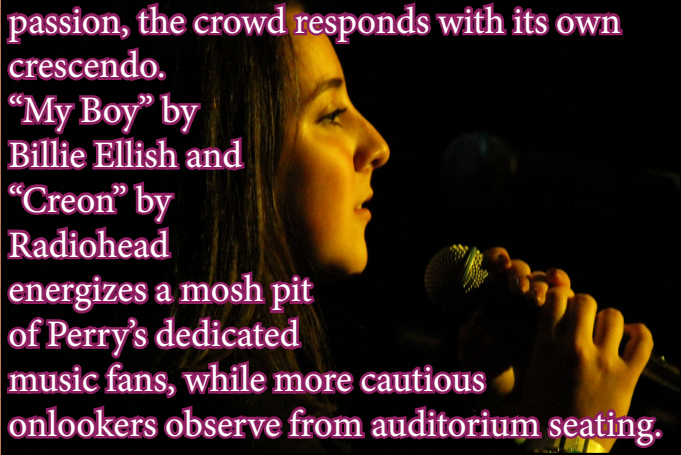


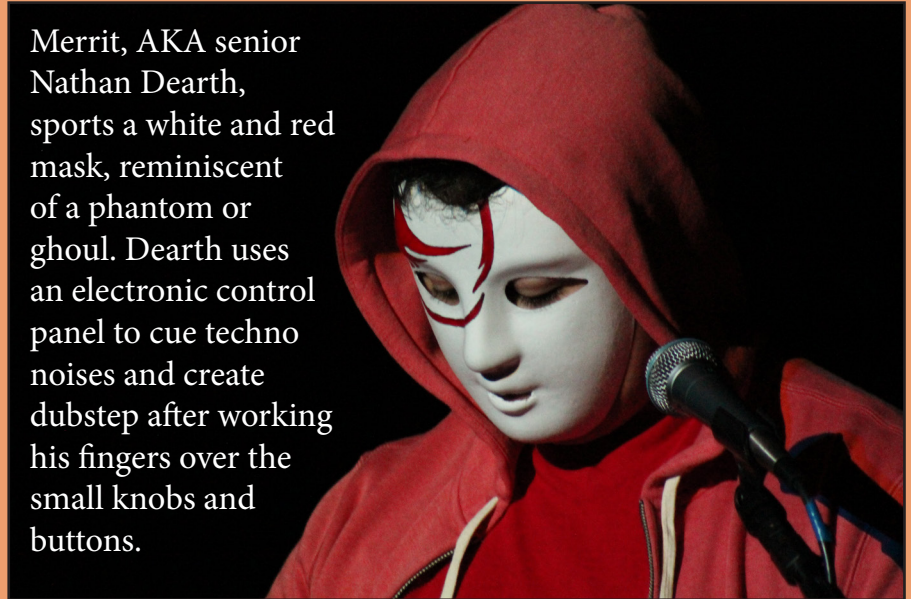
Falcons flock to Rock
